All entries must be received by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 5, 2026. No entries will be accepted after that time.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must be either a high school senior, first-time college freshmen, continuing college or trade school student, or person planning to return to college to finish an undergraduate degree. Graduate or doctoral students are not eligible.
- Applicant or applicant's parent or legal guardian must be a customer of Mire-Branch Water whose *primary residence* is in the water district and whose account is in good standing.
- Applicant must be planning to attend, on a full-time basis, any public or private Louisiana university or trade school. Graduate or doctoral students are not eligible.
- A continuing undergraduate or trade school student seeking the scholarship must have achieved a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale) on all prior college or trade school work.
